2	Rehabilitation and flood protection of the main water source												
3	Rehabilitation of the communal reservoir

5	Creation of two water points in the village												
6	Construction of a water point inside the courtyard of Al-Khattabiyah school including installation of a 5,000-liter water storage tank on the school grounds. and installation of of six child-friendly handwashing taps in accessible locations (All detailing specifications and engineering guidance are included in the BoQs)												
7	Supplying and installing a plastic water tank capacity of 1500 liter on the bathrooms roof including all accessories and belongings, as well as supplying and installing a pump to lift water from the ground tank 5000 liter to the roof tank 1500 liters, and supply and install plastic pipes 3/4 inch to feed the tanks on the roof of bathrooms with the water from the ground tank then to the latrines with all valves and fittings necessary for installation and running (All detailing specifications and engineering guidance are included in the BoQs)
