The contractor should provide submittals /products that meet the minimum technical specifications for the mentioned items in the BoQs and scope of work and provide an origin of goods, brands, and catalogs with the submission Annex 1	The offered samples/catalogs will be evaluated by comparing the mentioned specification items in the BoQs and scope of work. Any necessary physical samples, IMC technical committee will visit the proposed source of the offered samples in the local market to avoid any financial losses from submitting physical samples to competing contractors. Note:

2- **Mandatory:** Any vendor who does not pass the Technical Specifications Evaluation (TSE) with a score of 100% (40 out of 40 points) will be excluded from the remaining evaluation directly.

3- The winning vendor will be obligated to provide the required items as mentioned in the technical evaluation template and meet the specifications requirements outlined in the BoQs.
