Proposals for the services specified will be received by the ARK Corporate Services Department until the time and date stated above. Late or incomplete proposals will not be considered. Additional instructions for preparing a proposal are provided herein.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals from reputable and experienced Transportation Services providers to establish a Long-Term Agreement (LTA) with ARK for the provision of drivers and vehicle rental services. The chosen supplier will be expected to provide scheduled vehicle and driver services, as and when required for use throughout Yemen, per the requirements and details in the Statement of Work (SOW) in Annex 1. Vehicle and driver services will be requested through Call Down Orders (CDOs) and volume will be determined by operational demand and programmatic needs.

2. Description of Entity

ARK Group DMCC is a social enterprise specialising in stabilisation, development, peacebuilding, displacement, irregular migration, and Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism (P/CVE), primarily in Fragile and Conflict-Affected States (FCAS). Founded in 2012, ARK focuses on reconciling the human security needs of local communities with the concerns of governmental clients and international organisations. ARK's core activities encompass Research and Analysis, Monitoring & Evaluation, Capacity Building, and Programme & Project Design and Management. ARK employs a dedicated team of 140 staff members and consultants, working across eight countries and maintaining four country offices.

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- **d.** Failure to comply with any of the specified requirements may result in the bidder being considered unresponsive, leading to potential rejection of the proposal.
- **e.** Proposals will be received until 25 July 2024 at 18:00 (Aden Time). Proposals submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- f. Interested parties should notify ARK of their intention to bid by submitting an expression of interest (EOI) to procurement@arkgroupdmcc.com. Any changes to the tender and responses to requests for further information (RFI) will be sent to all potential bidders who have submitted an EOI.
- g. Discussions may be held to clarify proposals. If any such discussions are held, bidders will be notified that a best and final offer may be submitted by a revised deadline. The best and final offer provides the opportunity for bidders to revise their proposals based on additional information gathered during

discussions. If a best and final offer is not submitted, the previous offer will be considered as the best and final offer.

- h. Any questions raised regarding this RFP must be in writing and emailed to <u>procurement@arkgroupdmcc.com</u>. The RFP number should be quoted in all correspondence. ARK reserves the right to reject any and all proposals submitted and to request additional information from all bidders.
- i. ARK reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and request additional information if needed.
- **j.** The RFP process may lead to Long-Term Agreements (LTAs) with multiple companies, depending on the evaluation results.

5. Evaluation Criteria

A points formula will be used during the evaluation process to score proposals. If several proposals are closely ranked, ARK may arrange discussions with the bidders to assist in the selection process. Proposals will be evaluated and scored for both technical and price criteria. The maximum score for the technical and price proposal is 100 points (60 points for the technical criteria and 40 points for price). The <u>evaluation criteria are as follows:</u>

- **a. Mandatory Criteria**. The following criteria are mandatory and offers that do not meet them will be eliminated.
 - 1) The supplier must have proven experience providing rental services in the region with a minimum of 2 years, including references.
 - 2) The supplier must have a legitimate physical office and vehicle fleet in **Aden Governorate**. This will be visited and verified before the contract.
 - 3) All vehicles must be fully licensed and insured with comprehensive cover for all passengers.
 - 4) All drivers must be qualified and licensed to provide driver services throughout the term of the contract.
 - 5) All vehicles must carry a comprehensive first aid kit, spare tire, and tool kit.
 - 6) Capability to supply suitable vehicles during the period from 01 August 2024 to 31 July 2025 both on a long-term and short-term basis.
 - 7) All vehicles must be roadworthy, properly serviced, and clean and tidy at all times.

c. Price Criteria (maximum 40 points)

Only bidders meeting the minimum threshold of 40 points in the technical evaluation will be taken forward to the price evaluation. The maximum number of points for the Price Proposal is 40. The maximum score for price will be assigned to the bidder offering the lowest price and proportional scores will be assigned to the other proposals.

Annex 1: STATEMENT OF WORK

Transportation Services Long-Term Agreement – Yemen

1. Background

ARK Group DMCC (hereinafter referred to as "ARK") is a stabilisation and development company committed to empowering local communities and beneficiaries in conflict, post-conflict, and fragile areas through evidence-based programmatic interventions, policy recommendations, research, and capacity-building. ARK is registered in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, with branch offices in Jordan, Lebanon, Yemen, and the UK. The services under this Request for Proposal (RFP) are required for ARK Group's Aden branch office.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this Statement of Work (SOW) is to outline the scope, deliverables, timelines, and responsibilities for the successful delivery of vehicle and driver services in Yemen. This document serves as a formal agreement between the client and the service provider, providing clear and detailed guidelines to ensure mutual understanding and alignment of expectations for ARK's transportation requirements in Yemen.

The SOW establishes a clear understanding of collaboration, communication, and accountability throughout the provision of vehicle and driver services. By defining the service objectives, vehicle specifications, driver qualifications, insurance, and safety measures, this SOW facilitates efficient and reliable transportation support to project personnel in Yemen.

3. Description of Services Required

ARK is seeking a transportation service provider, based and registered in Aden, to supply vehicles with fuel and drivers on an as-needed basis from 01 August 2024 to 31 July 2025. Key features of this on-demand service include:

- A. Supply 4x4 SUVs (seven-seater) with engine sizes of 4.0 L (Toyota Prado or equivalent), and SUV 4x4 (five-seater) with engine sizes of 2.7L (Toyota Fortuner or equivalent).
- B. Capability to provide hybrid vehicles, with at least one option for 4x4 SUVs (seven-seater) with engine sizes of 3.8L, and SUV 4x4 (five-seater) with engine sizes of 2.5L.
- C. Supply Sedan vehicle (five-seater) with an engine size of 1.6 L To 2.0 L (Toyota Corolla or equivalent)
- D. Supply Full-size SUV Pickup truck with an engine size of 4.0 L (Toyota Land Crouser 70 series or equivalent)
- E. Supply Van vehicle (eight eleven-seater) with an engine size of 2.5 L (Hyundai H1 or equivalent)
- F. Supply vehicle models that are not older than 2021 and milage not exceeding 80,000 KM.
- G. All vehicles must have automatic transmissions.
- G. Mileage Range coverage and fuel breakdown every month.
- 24-hour emergency breakdown and emergency assistance with replacement vehicles provided if necessary.
- J. In case of any accidents, a replacement vehicle must be provided by the service provider at no additional cost to ARK until the rented vehicle is repaired.
- K. Maintenance package to include routine servicing.
- L. All vehicles must be older than 2021 and milage not exceeding 80,000 KM.
- M. All offered vehicles must be registered and licensed.
- N. A fully comprehensive insurance policy.
- O. Each vehicle must have a fire extinguisher, tire jack, and tire puncture maintenance tools for emergency breakdowns.



These services must be available 24/7. While ARK will generally provide advance notice for transportation needs, there may be instances requiring very short notice. The provider must ensure safe and reliable transportation for project personnel within the Southern governorates of Yemen

ARK does not guarantee a minimum or specific volume of services. However, the service provider commits to meeting ARK's transportation needs to the best of their abilities whenever required.

4. Timeframe

This service will be required for 12 months, starting from 01 August 2024 to 31 July 2025, with the option to amend the contract for an additional 1 year subject to mutual agreement and satisfactory performance.

5. Milestones and Payment Schedule

Invoices for the provided services will be submitted by the service provider on the last day of each month. These invoices will include a detailed breakdown of costs for each day of travel, clearly outlining the expenses incurred during the service period. ARK will process payments upon receipt and verification of the itemized invoices. The payment terms will be as follows:

- ARK will pay the service provider net-30 days from receipt and verification of invoices and log sheets submitted by the service provider. The payment will cover the services rendered during the respective month
- If the contract is extended for an additional six months, the payment schedule for the extended period will follow the same monthly invoicing and payment terms as outlined above.

The monthly invoices with a comprehensive breakdown of costs for each day of travel will allow for transparent financial tracking and ensure accurate reimbursement for the actual services provided. ARK and the service provider will collaboratively review the invoices to ensure clarity and accuracy for a smooth payment process throughout the project duration, including any potential extension period.

6. Requirements and Qualifications

The service provider must meet several requirements to ensure the safe and efficient provision of vehicle and driver services for ARK. These requirements include:

- Licensing and Registration: The service provider must be licensed to operate as a transportation services provider with a valid company registration and fixed business premises, also the service provider must ensure that all vehicles are registered and licensed.
- Proven Work Experience: The service provider must have a track record of proven work experience in
 providing reliable and professional vehicle and driver services. This requirement assures ARK of the
 provider's competence and expertise in the field.
- Vehicle Quality and Safety: All vehicles must be in excellent working condition, regularly serviced, and
 free from any defects or issues that may compromise the safety and functionality of the vehicle. In
 addition, all vehicles must be fitted with stickers on the dashboard and back of front seats, containing
 readable national emergency numbers (police, fire brigade, ambulance service, and the company's HQ
 / emergency numbers. Additionally, the company must keep a tracking log of all vehicles and
 recommends having a GPS tracking system for all vehicles.
- Vehicle visibility: vehicles dispatched to ARK should not have visibility that exposes ARK staff and
 programs to risk, all cars should be neutral without any markings or tags that provoke local communities
 or checkpoints.



- Comprehensive Insurance: All vehicles offered must have full comprehensive insurance coverage. This
 measure protects ARK from potential financial liabilities in case of unforeseen incidents, also a detailed
 insurance coverage plan for vehicles and passengers is required.
- Emergency Preparedness: The service provider must equip all vehicles with a regular emergency kit, including essentials like a fire extinguisher (minimum 6kg foam), first aid kit, spare tires, and vehicle jack, and carry spare fuel and tire puncture maintenance tools, 1-2 fire blanket, heavy duty tow rope, and meet all safety requirements. This preparedness ensures the ability to handle unforeseen situations effectively. Additional recommended items include an illuminating vest and emergency triangles. hand flashlight. Recommended safety items include a pressure-calibrated tire inflator and gloves.
- Qualified and Knowledgeable Drivers: All drivers must possess valid driving licenses and thorough knowledge of Aden governorate's road network and traffic regulations. This requirement assures ARK that skilled and experienced drivers will be responsible for their personnel's transportation. The drivers must be familiar with basic repairs, such as tire changes, jumping batteries, and emergency communications/reporting to company HQ. The company is solely responsible for the behavior of the drivers, their health, and wellbeing, and must ensure that the drivers are not under the influence while on duty, they are not overworked, and are not driving when they are sick. The global best practices indicate that a healthy driver must take a break between every 4 driving hours. No driver should drive more than 10 hours daily.
- Environmental Responsibility: As part of ARK's commitment to promoting environmental responsibility, the service provider must consider environmental sustainability in all activities. This includes maintaining vehicles to reduce emissions and contributing to a healthier environment with reduced air pollution.
- Ethics: The service provider will adhere to the principles of the UN Global Compact throughout the term of service by:
 - Adhering to these comprehensive requirements, ARK aims to secure a dependable and responsible service provider that aligns with its values and ensures the successful implementation of its projects in Yemen.
